Day 1: Lima

Arrive in Lima and transfer to selected hotel for overnight stay.

Day 2: Lima (B)

Enjoy Lima's streets and plazas. Begin in the Miraflores and San Isidro before heading to the Historical Center to visit the Convent of Santo Domingo. Enjoy a Pisco Sour tour and visit the Larco Museum, which houses a private collection of Ancient Peru Treasures.

Day 3: Lima - Paracas (B)

After breakfast, transfer to Paracas and selected hotel.

Day 4: Paracas - Nazca (B)

Today, you will visit the Ballestas Islands to see thousands of marine birds and sea lions. See the famous Candelabra design before heading back to Nazca for the night.

Day 5: Nazca - Arequipa (B)

This morning, board a small plane that will fly over the Nazca Lines and see geoglyphs among the huge labyrinth of lines engraved on the earth and preserved for about 2,000 years. Then transfer to Arequipa for overnight stay in selected hotel.

Day 6: Arequipa (B)

Enjoy a half day tour to walk the streets of Arequipa. Begin in the Plaza de Armas before heading to the Monastery of Santa Catalina, which has remained intact for centuries. Finally, visit the beautiful Barrio del Solar and the Church of La Compania de Jesus, made with ashlar volcanic stone. Rest of the day at your leisure.

Day 7: Puno - Cusco (B)

Today, travel through the town of Yura and through the National Reserve of Aguada Blanca and Pampa Canahuas before arriving in Colca for an afternoon at your leisure. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 8: Colca – Puno (B, L)

Head to the Cruz del Condor (Condor Cross) to admire the stunning Colca Canyon and potentially see the Andean Condors. Then, drive to Puno stopping by Pinchollo, Maca and Chivay along the way. Overnight in Puno at selected hotel.

Day 9: Puno (B,L)

Today, visit the amazing Lake Titicaca Lake, the highest in the world. Travel by boat to Taquile Island to learn about the remaining cultures and traditions before visiting the floating islands of Uros, also called the "Village of the Lake", built with cattail reeds. Overnight in Puno.

Day 10: Puno – Cusco (B,L)

Journey to Cusco with amazing landscapes of the Southern Valley of Cusco. Visit La Raya for a beautiful view of the mountains, and the ruins of Racchi, the Temple of God Wiracocha. Finally, visit the town of Andahuaylillas before arriving in Cusco for overnight stay in selected hotel.

Day 11: Cusco (B)

Today, explore the imperial city beginning at the Koricancha Temple, the main place of worship of the Sun God, followed by the main square. Visit the Sacsayhuaman Fortress, an example of Inca military architecture, and the archaeological site at Kenko. Finally, enjoy an Inka's Expression art workshop. Overnight at selected hotel.

Day 12: Cusco – Sacred Valley (B,L)

Discover the best of the Sacred Valley, including the Maras salt terraces where some of the world's finest salt is extracted. Then visit Ollantaytambo ruins, a fortress that also served as a temple, and walk through the town, known to be the only living Inca city. Transfer to selected hotel for overnight in Sacred Valley.

Day 13: Sacred Valley – Machu Picchu - Cusco (B,L)

Take the "Voyager" train to the remarkable citadel of Machu Picchu. One of the Seven Wonders of the World, you'll enjoy a guided tour and free time to explore the area. Admire the incredibly preserved ruins before heading back to Aguas Calientes to transfer back to Cusco for your overnight stay.

Day 14: Cusco

Transfer to the airport for your flight back home, or to an on-going destination.

Day 1: Lima

A guide will pick you up from the airport and will transfer you to the hotel.

Day 2: Lima (B)

In the morning, take a tour through Lima's streets and plazas. Beginning in "Parque del Amor" – the Love Park – in Miraflores, you'll get a spectacular view of the Pacific Ocean.

Then, head to the Huaca Pucllana, the ceremonial center of the Lima culture. Visit the Cathedral and the Santo Domingo Convent.

Afternoon at your leisure.

Day 3: Lima - Cusco (B)

Today, fly to Cusco and transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, visit the archaeological park of Sacsayhuaman. An excursion will take you to the fortress of the same name, with rocks measuring up to 4 metres high. Head to Q'enqo, an ancient temple of the Puma, and view the altar for sacrifices.

Then, to Tambomachay – the sacred fountains of life and health. One of the way, see the Puca Pucara, the watch tower that once controlled the entrance to the city.

Next, visit the Temple of the Sun or the "Korikancha", entirely lined in gold sheets. Finally, head back to the Main Square to see the cathedral and other works of art.

Day 4: Cusco - Sacred Valley (B,L)

Begin your journey to the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Visit Awanacancha to feed some llamas and alpacas, and learn of the weaving and dyeing techniques of the locals and their traditional textiles. Visit the Colonial Pisac atop a mountain. Shop in the handicraft market and enjoy the Inkariy Museum.

After lunch, a guided tour of the museum will teach you of the cultural representations of the pre-Hispanic civilizations of ancient Peru.

Day 5: Sacred Valley - Machu Picchu (B,L)

Continue your journey to other treasures of the Sacred Valley. In Moray, admire the colossal concentric terraces that simulate an amphitheater, but in actuality, recreate 20 different types of microclimates, guaranteeing the agricultural production of the empire. In Maras, visit the millenary colonial salt mines. After a buffet lunch, you will visit the archaeological site of Ollantaytambo to learn of the stone working techniques of the Incas.

Finish your trip day in Aguas Calientes.

Day 6: Machu Picchu - Cusco (B,L)

Today is the big day to Machu Picchu. Take a bus up a winding road, viewing the Urubamba River and the canyon. Waiting for your arrival – the Lost City of the Incas, Machu Picchu. Terraces, ceremonial shrines, steps and more, this is sure to be a wonder. Enjoy your surroundings and the history before heading back to the town for lunch and your trip to Ollantaytambo.

Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 7: Cusco - Chachapoyas (B,L)

A few flights will get you to Jaen, today, and then off to Chachapoyas. This trip will take approximately 5 hours. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 8: Chachapoyas (B,L)

In the morning, visit Kuelap, an archaeological site built by the Chachapoyas. Head to Nuevo Tingo town and arrive at the Cable Car station which will take you Kuelap. Hike or ride on horseback to the "Foretress", built upon the Cerro Barreta and admire the beautiful landscapes around you. With complex architecture, robust walls and cliffs, it is clear that an organized population lived here.

Take in your surroundings before returning to Nuevo Tingo town for lunch and back to Chachapoyas city.

Day 9: Chachapoyas (B,L)

Today, visit San Pablo de Valera and onwards to Gocta waterfall, also known as "La Chorrera". Horseback and a short hike will get you here. At 771 metres high, it is considered among the highest waterfalls in the world. Plenty of wildlife resides here such as toucans, monkeys and mountain lions. Amidst a cloud-covered and waterfall abundant forest, you'll truly be in a beautiful natural environment.

Day 9: Chachapoyas - Lima (B)

Transport to the airport for your flight back home, or to an ongoing destination.

7 Nights/8 Days

INCA TRAIL

Begin with a drive through the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Once you arrive at KM 82, you will prepare for the hike ahead, alongside your excursion team. Cross a bridge to the other side of the river and begin your ascent paralleling the Urubamba River. Visit the Miskay community and drink the local “chicha” before climbing to a plateau to view the Andes and the Patallacta. After camping for the night, an early morning will lead you to climbing the famous Warmy Huañuska pass. A difficult but rewarding hike, you’ll make it to the top of the mountain to see the Andes and the Inca Trail. After camping at the comfortable Pacaymayo, the longest day of your journey lies ahead, but with some of the most spectacular Incan buildings scattered along the trail. Ruins like the Runukrakai, the Sayacmarca, Phuyupatamarca and the Wiñaywayna will be on your trek before a small goodbye party to some of the excursion team for helping you get to the final destination: Machu Picchu. Located in the middle of a tropical forest, this is one of the most amazing urban creation of the Inca Empire. You’ll take a two-hour tour through this beautiful Incan citadel before returning back to Cusco.

8 Nights/9 Days

ANDEAN MARVELS AND THE UYUNI SALT FLAT

In Lima, you will take a half day tour of the Historical Center, visiting the modern and colonial parts of Lima, known as the City of Kings. You’ll enjoy views at Miraflores and San Isidro, and take pictures at the Plaza de Armas. The following day, you’ll head to Cusco for a city tour including the San Pedro local market, the Korikancha Temple (an ancient Incan palace and cult center of the Sun God), the Cathedral in the Plaza de Armas, the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman and Kenko (Q’enko – an archeological site where important Inca ceremonies took place). Then, you will visit one of the world’s most famous landmarks: the citadel of Machu Picchu. After the train ride to Aguas Calientes, you will ascend to this world wonder and enjoy free time exploring. Next, you’ll head to Puno, visiting Andahuaylillas, Racchi and Puca Pucara on the way. In Puno, you’ll visit the islands of Uros and Taquile, in the greater area of Lake Titicaca. Here, you’ll learn about the culture and traditions being kept alive. Finally, you’ll make the great expedition to the great Salt Flats of Uyuni. Marvel at the unique and isolated ecosystem populated by giant cacti.

AUTHENTIC PERU

On this tour, you’ll get a truly authentic look at Peru. You will visit Lima and Cusco, two of the most famous cities in Peru. See the panoramic view of “La Huaca Pucllana” and the district of Miraflores. In Cusco, visit the temple of the sun and four ruins: the archeological complex of Sacsayhuaman, Qenko, Puca-pucara and Tambomachay. After these few days, you’ll travel to the Sacred Valley of the Incas, visiting the Archaeological Complex of Pisac Ruins and Market, and Ollantaybambo. A train will take you to Aguas Calientes, and from there, a bus to the famous Machu Picchu. This fabulous city contains houses, temples, warehouses, a large central square; all connected by narrow roads and steps that are surrounded by terraces cut into the mountain side. After a full day of exploring this historical Seven Wonder of the World, you’ll have another chance to explore more of Cusco to end off your tour.

Day 1: Quito

Arrive in Quito and transfer from the airport to the hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 2: Quito (B,L,D)

After breakfast, we will start our city tour. We'll drive from the north of the city, where the Quito's commercial and residential area is located. We'll continue to the colonial area where we will have a walking tour through the streets of Quito's historical centre. Visiting Plaza de la Independencia, surrounded by the main buildings which governing the political and the religious life of the city and the country; the Cathedral, Archbishop's Palace, The City Hall and the Government Palace. La Compañía Church where you can appreciate its magnificent architecture. The tour continues in our transportation to the Panecillo Hill, a landscape where the winged Virgin of Quito stands, it custodies the city of Quito and where you can see the shape of its streets and a large view. After city Tour we will do Middle of the World Monument. At the end of the tour return to the hotel. Overnight in Quito.

Day 3: Arrival at Baltra Airport – Bachas (B,L,D)

Departure to the Galapagos Islands, arrival at the airport of Baltra Island with reception of our naturalist guide of the National Park.

After a hike, you can swim or snorkel from the beach. There are excellent rocky areas to see a great diversity of fish, octopus and, with some luck, blue sharks!

Overnight for the remainder of the voyage on the EcoGalaxy Catamaran

Day 4: Sullivan Bay – Bartholomew (B,L,D)

Today, you'll enjoy a hike in Sullivan Bay over a Pahoehoe lava flow in perfect condition. In this incredible landscape, you'll be surprised to find pioneer plants and lava lizards. On the coast, you can see penguins and other seabirds. Go snorkeling from a small coral sand beach or from the pangas.

In the evening, you'll be able to snorkel at Bartolome, an area with a well-deserved excellent diving reputation.

Day 5: Upper Town - Charles Darwin Station (B,L,D)

Today you'll visit the upper part of Santa Cruz. You will visit some of the giant tortoises reserves to observe these gentle giants in their natural environment. You will also visit a lava tunnel to learn about the origin of these geological formations.

In the evening, you will visit the Charles Darwin Station – an NGO that for decades has worked with Galapagos National Park in the conservation of the islands' native species.

Day 6: Cormorant Point – Devil's Crown – Post Office Bay (B,L,D)

At this visiting site, you will explore a saline coastal lagoon where you will observe shorebirds and an important colony of pink flamingos. On the trail, you will also visit a beautiful beach of very fine coral sand – an important nesting place for sea turtle in the Galapagos! Enjoy a snorkel in the famous Devil's Crown, considered one of the best diving spots on the islands for the huge number of fish, reef sharks, rays and turtles. In the afternoon, you'll visit post barrel, where whalers once used, and continue to this day, as a post office.

Day 7: Punta Suarez – Gardner Bay (B,L,D)

Today, you'll embark on a rocky trail with an impressive variety of fauna. You'll see sea lions, iguanas, and have the opportunity to visit a colony of waved albatrosses.

In the afternoon, you'll visit Gardner Bay, with an important colony of sea lions that inhabit the beautiful beach.

Day 8: Interpretation Center – Transfer to Quito (B)

In the morning, head to the Interpretation Center. Located on the outskirts of town, this center is dedicated to the human history of the Galapagos.

In the afternoon, transfer back to Quito for flight home or to on-going destination.

8 Nights/9 Days

ANDES & GALAPAGOS ISLANDS

On this tour, you will get to explore the majestic Ecuadorian Andes, enjoy a walk in the imposing Cotopaxi, and visit the enchanted islands of the Galapagos, with its spectacular flora and fauna. After a beautiful excursion to Cotopaxi, a beautiful active stratovolcano in the Andes Mountains, you'll transfer out of Quito and onto a Galapagos Cruise. Enjoy all the wonders Galapagos has to offer over 5 days, from the diverse variety of flora and fauna, to the incredible wildlife.

You will then visit the wondrous Machu Picchu – the Lost City of the Incas. Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this 15th-century Inca citadel is truly breathtaking. The following day, you will bid farewell to Peru and arrive in Quito, Ecuador to enjoy the capital city, the colonial architecture, and the 'Mitad del Mundo' – the Middle of the World. You will then head on a Galapagos Cruise for 5 days, learning about the variety of diverse flora, fauna and wildlife in this amazing landscape.

Day 1: Bariloche

Arrive in Bariloche and transfer from the airport to the hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 2: Bariloche (B,L,D)

After breakfast, you will begin the circuit tour, heading to Cerro Campanario, where you will see the Nahuel Huapi and Perito Moreno lakes, the El Trebol Lagoon, Victoria Island, and much more. Enjoy the panoramic view of Lake Moreno and Llao Llao peninsula. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 3: Bariloche – El Calafate (B,D)

Depart to the airport to take a flight to El Calafate. Transfer into the chosen hotel. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 4: El Calafate (B,L,D)

Start your day with an excursion to the Perito Moreno Glacier. Bordering Lake Argentino, you will observe a large number of European hardes, black-winged easles, and more before the glacial viewpoint. Different walkways with varying difficulties provide excellent views of the glacier front. It is the only glacier that ruptures every few years. Optional: Nautical Safari – includes a quiet observation walk.

Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 5: El Calafate (B)

After breakfast, enjoy your day of leisure. Option to travel to Puerto Banderas for an Ice Rivers excursion, where you can navigate between a large number of icebergs up to the Upsala Glacier and the Spegazzini Glacier.

Day 6: El Calafate - Ushuaia (B)

Depart to the airport to take a flight to Ushuaia. Transfer to chosen hotel. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 7: Ushuaia (B)

After breakfast, enjoy the Tierra del Fuego National Park, where you'll find the lenga and sour cherry forests in these coastal environments. Option to take the "End of the World" Train to learn about the area. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 8: Ushuaia (B)

After breakfast, enjoy your day of leisure. Option to explore the Beagle Channel and the famous Faro Les Eclaireurs historical site.

Day 9: Ushuaia Puerto Madryn (B)

Depart to the airport to take a flight to trelew. Transfer to chosen hotel. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 10: Puerto Madryn (B,L,D)

After an early breakfast, begin your excursion towards the Peninsular Valdes Provincial Reserve, a protected natural area. After, enjoy a remarkable whale watching experience (between the months of June and December). Later in the day, you will enter the Valdes Peninsula to observe a wide variety of wildlife from guanacos to foxes. Finally, see the Salinas Grandes and Chica, two large endorheic circular depressions from tectonic subsidence. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 11: Puerto Madryn (B)

After breakfast, enjoy your day of leisure. Option to tour Punta Tombo, a protected natural reserve that holds the largest colony of Megallanic penguins! Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 12: Puerto Madryn

Transfer to the airport for your flight back home, or to an on-going destination.

9 Nights/10 Days

TORRES DEL PAINE & PATAGONIA TOUR

Start this tour in El Chalten, a village in the heart of Los Glaciares National Park. This will be your base as you spend the next few days hiking until you reach the granite peaks of Fitz Roy! Make sure to eat your breakfast each day as this is two days of hiking in the park. Options include a trip to Torre Lagoon and to the base of Mt. Torre or to De Los Tres Lagoon and Fitz Roy Base Camp. In El Calafate, you will take a full day tour to Perito Moreno Glacier with a trek on the glacier. After a short boat ride and learning session about the geography and how to walk with crampons, you will spend approximately three hours walking through crevasses and exploring the ice landscape. The following day you will continue on the Norden-skjold Lake excursion. Cross rivers, descend sandy dunes and visit gorgeous surroundings, all while enjoying the possibility to practice and learn about horses. In the following days, you will also visit Grey Lake, take a boat ride to Grey Glacier, Armarga Lagoon and Azul Lagoon.



6 Nights/7 Days

AUTHENTIC ARGENTINA

Start your week with a half-day city tour of Buenos Aires. You will visit the National Congress, the ancient Council, the Metropolitan Cathedral, and the Colon Theatre, one of the 5 most important Opera theatres in the world. You will visit San Telmo area, one of the most antique districts of the city, as well as the Boca district, with its "caminito" - a picturesque pedestrian street. The following day, you will visit the northern area of Buenos Aires with a half-day Tigre tour. On your way to Tigre area, you will pass by the Presidential residence in Olivos district and reach San Isidro district where you will visit the train station, commercial mall and craft market. Once in Tigre area, you will get on a catamaran to enjoy a relaxing trip with a wonderful view of the Parana Delta, an area of subtropical rainforest made of a thousand islands and islets. In the evening, you will enjoy a Dinner and Tango Show. Then you are off to Iguazu Falls! There are more than 270 waterfalls along the cliffs and islets. The paths can be covered on foot or by a little train. The National Park has 2 circuits to be covered: lower and upper. In the lower circuit, one can reach the base of the falls, where the magnificence of their beauty can be appreciated. In the upper circuit, the tour is a bit more sedentary, where unique landscapes can be viewed from footbridges and viewpoints - an unforgettable experience.



11 Nights/12 Days

ARGENTINA ADVENTURE

Begin your tour exploring the beautiful Buenos Aires by getting to know the civic center, stopping at La Boca, famous for its picturesque and colourful architecture, and finally, visiting La Recoleta, one of the most exclusive neighborhoods in the city. From there, you'll visit Salta and learn the culture and histories at various museums. The following day, you will visit Cafayate to enjoy the tobacco growing fields, the small town architecture, and well known wine tastings. You'll then head back to Salta and through to Tastil, Salinas Grandes, and eventually Purmamarca and the Seven Colors Mountain. If visiting during the turtle nesting season, be amazed by the different species of sea turtles that come to Tortuguero to nest like the Green, Leatherback, Hawksbill and Loggerhead sea turtles or watch the turtles hatch and make their way back to the sea! There's plenty of wildlife to view in the area so make sure to keep an eye out. Overnight in selected hotel.

Day 4: Tortuguero - Arenal (B,L,D)

Today will be a travel day. Take a boat to Guápiles and enjoy lunch before your journey from Guápiles to Arenal. The trip to La Fortuna area of San Carlos is roughly 3 hours and you'll have the option of their using a shared transfer, where someone will pick you up, or pick up a car rental of your choice. Next, drive to the village of Óbidos. This medieval walled town is full of Gothic churches, narrow winding streets, and small shops where you can taste the famous *ginjinha* (cherry liqueur). End your day in Fátima. The next day you will visit two monasteries: the Monastery of Santa Maria and the Santa Maria da Vitoria. The first is in Alco- baça and houses the largest church in the country. The second is in Batalha. Between these two cities, take a lunch break at the pictur- esque fishing village of Nazaré. Known for its great waves, surfers all over the world flock to the beautiful bay. Continue to Porto, located on the mouth of the Douro, and visit its historical center. Do not miss the Cathedral, the Clérigos Tower, the Ribeira area, Casa da Música and the Serralves Foundation. Head to the fantastic Douro Valley wine region. During the journey, stop on the spectacular belvederes and admire the landscapes! In your final days, you will be visiting Tomar, Fátima, Estremoz and Evora where you will visit Roman temples and church- es. Back to Lisbon for a leisure day to explore before you head home, or to a new adventure.

On day one explore Lisbon including the old Alfama district and its Praça do Comércio. Visit the historic district of Belem and its Belem Tower and the Monument of the Discoveries. Then, travel to Spain to visit Santiago de Compostela – the third most important pilgrimage city. Explore the city of Santiago de Compostela for a full day. Visit the beautiful and picturesque Cathedral. The following day depart for Burgos, and visit the magnificent cathedral. You might have the opportunity to participate or watch a Mass. On your final day enjoy a full day in Lourdes. Visit the Grotto, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the Basilica of the Rosary and Via Sacra. Today is Devotion to Our Lady of Lourdes. In the evening, you will have the opportunity to participate in the candlelit procession.
